Learning Outcome

Outcomes/Key Points

- Identify key knowledge, skills and abilities (KSA) that the student will need to obtain in order to successfully obtain a job in their chosen field.
- Identify what KSA they currently have and how they can obtain the additional KSAs.
- Identify what community supports are available to help students achieve their goal.

Steps/Activities – Exploring and Preparing for City of Thunder Bay Jobs

Using the City of Thunder Bay virtual career fair webpage (www.thunderbay.ca/careerfair) and the knowledge, skills and abilities documents available and your personal profile, pick a grouping of jobs that interests you.

Identify the following:

1. What Division interests you the most?
2. What level of position interests you (Managerial, Professional/Technical, Trade, Administrative or Operations)?
3. What position example listed interests you the most?
4. What education do you need for careers in your chosen area?
 - a. Is there a Specialized High School Major (SHSM) that relates to careers in the field you choose?
 - b. Are there courses you can take in high school to prepare you for the career you have chosen?
5. What type of experience do you need for careers in your chosen area?
 - a. How will you get this experience and/or what transferrable skills do you already have?
6. What type of skills and abilities do you need for careers in your chosen area?

- a. How will you get these skills/abilities and/or what transferrable skills/abilities do you already have?
7. What resources do we have in Thunder Bay can assist you in achieving your goals?
 - a. Can you gain the education required in Thunder Bay?
